

A-CDM in CPH

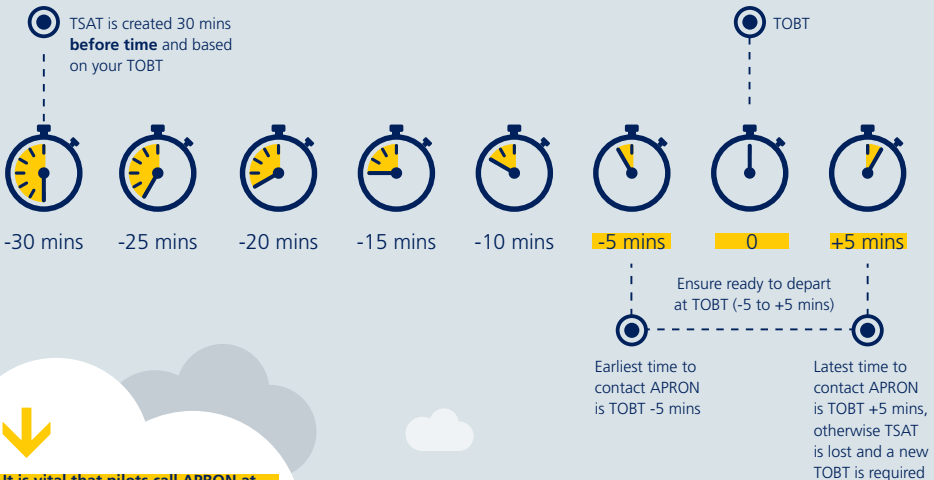


Best Planned – Best Served

A-CDM means airport partners work closely together and openly share data in real-time by implementing a set of operational procedures and automated processes.

A-CDM creates predictability for all partners and provides the opportunity to use resources in the best possible way: aircraft, fuel, equipment and staff.

- **A-CDM:** Airport Collaborative Decision Making
- **TOBT:** Target Off Block Time
- **TSAT:** Target Start-up Approval Time
- **CTOT:** Calculated Take-Off Time
- **TTOT:** Target Take-Off Time



It is vital that pilots call APRON at TOBT +/- 5 minutes even if TSAT is, and/or CTOT is outside this window

-5 mins = 5 mins before time
+5 mins = 5 mins after time

1) Dialogue with Ground Handler.

You should make sure that your aircraft is ready to push at TOBT.

Please maintain regular communication with the ground handler – They are responsible for updating your TOBT:

- If you identify a delay to TOBT of more than +5 or believe you will be ready to depart earlier than TOBT -5, notify your ground handler right away.

NB: The ground handler will not update your TOBT without first consulting you

2) Dialogue with ATC (APRON).

You must contact APRON at TOBT +/- 5 minutes.

- You will either receive Start Up Approval, or will be advised of your TSAT.

Keep monitoring the frequency, and contact APRON at TSAT.

- When start-up request has been made do not update TOBT. Doing so will affect your number in the sequence.
- If you have not reported ready for departure by TOBT +5, you will lose your TSAT and a new TOBT is required. Your handler will need to set this new TOBT.
